



Structural level

Institutionalization of drawing on innovation potential of SSH

- First time appliers to TACR
- Focus on science-to-science (basic research) so far
- Poor focus on science-to-public/ professionals (applied research)
- Third role of universities omitted

#Better know-how transfer and institutional appreciation for applications

Political level

Blindness of legislation and R&D policy to the needs of SSH

- Not all are eligible applicants
- Legislation doesn't folow SSH nature
- Does the SSH always need to be supported under the State aid rules or not (Framework, EC Regulation)?
- R&D policy ignores artistic research

#Greater attention on SSH nature during legislation processes and governance of R&D

Academic level

Innovative mind-set of SSH community

- Inactivity of majority of SSH community critical attitude towards deamand-oriented research
- Lack on novelty and innovativeness
- · Willingness to take risk is low
- Fear of new methods and partners

#Closer communication among academia, funding org., authorities



Conclusions

• ETA programme is in the early stage, but seems to work:

Even though the programme is at the start of its implementation, first experiences show that it creates an appropriate tool in harnessing the innovation potential of SSH.

Application Guarantee build up a bridge:

The novelty lies in the fact that, through the role of an application guarantor, it encourages building partnerships between SSH community and their clients.

RFOs needs to reflect and innovate, too!

However, there is a need to deepen the relationship between the SSH community and the Research Funding Organisation and to constantly reflect the way the interventions (ETA programme) is implemented.

SSH still invisible for legislation, policy and government of R&D

An important part of the success of the programme is both the parallel adjustment of legislation and policies on national and EU levels in such a way that better reflects the specific nature of SSH, and structural exploitation of the innovation potential of SSH for society of the 21st century.
